

# Curbridge - Annual District Church Meeting 2019 Minutes

*Sunday 7 April 2019 after the 9.15a.m. Service, starting at 10.00a.m.*

Chairman: Rev Ross Meikle + 9 people present. Apologies: Rev Tim and Esther Partridge, Valerie Pole.

Minutes of last year's meeting were circulated and approved.

Matters Arising: The Saturday churchyard working party proposed for 26 May 2018 had not taken place.

Election of Deputy Wardens and/or PCC reps.: There were no volunteers for Deputy Warden. Christine Lever agreed to be a PCC rep. for Curbridge, was thanked and elected nem. con. proposed by Betty Hughes, seconded by Pamela Wilson. The Chairman encouraged anyone who was willing to serve to speak to one of the Ministry Team.

Review of the Year: This was to be found in the booklet Benefice of Witney Review of the Year 2018, a copy of which was available to everyone in the Church.

Relinquishment of Responsibilities of Curbridge DCC: Motion "This meeting agrees that the responsibilities of Curbridge District Church Council will be held and carried out by the DCC of the Church of St. Mary the Virgin, Witney". Proposed by Jean Greenway, seconded by Betty Hughes and passed nem. con.

Any Other Business: Rev Tim Partridge was proposing to approach the Wychwood Forest Project Volunteers about further repairs now required to the churchyard wall. Other practical matters such as cleaning the Church building and mowing the grass in the churchyard were for the Friends of the Church, who would meet later.

A copy of the 2018 Annual Report and Accounts for the Parish of Witney had been placed at the back of the Church for people to read.

Welcome cards for visitors to each Church in the Benefice were being produced and would be delivered shortly.

The meeting ended with a prayer at 10.15a.m.
