We also encourage you to bring your own plates, cutlery and drinking vessels and take them home afterwards to wash.

There will be no need to enter the church at any time, unless you need the toilet. And we will not move into the church if the weather is not being kind. So please dress appropriately.

We hope that everyone will still be happy to pay £5.00 – even though the fare is somewhat reduced – as all proceeds are going to a very worthwhile cause, the Berks, Bucks and Oxfordshire Wildlife Trust. This has been chosen to help support Great Big Green Week. There will also be a raffle for BBOWT, but we will keep this to a few prizes donated by members of the team.
